



RECREATIONAL CLUB SAFEGUARDING SELF-ASSESSMENT

The purpose of this support tool is to help clubs identify risk and ensure your club is providing robust safeguarding for your members and anyone involved with your club.

Use this checklist to action plan and help embed safeguarding throughout your club.

POLICY AND RISK MANAGEMENT		
Club Signs up to <u>ECB Safe Hands Policy</u> and this is documented in the club's constitution or in a policy statement		
Club follows ECB guidance and implements its own policies. Club uses the <u>Safeguarding Kit Bag</u> for Policy, Templates and Guidance.		
Risk Assessments include Safeguarding Considerations Templates available from <i>County Safeguarding Officer</i>		
Risk assessment for score box has been done for junior scorers. E.G juniors score from open area, not within a score box. Rule of two is in place.		

Codes of conduct are in place for juniors, seniors, coaches/volunteers and parent/spectators and are communicated, signed up to and displayed

ECB Recreational Cricket Safety Regulations

are communicated to parents and children and are adhered to. E.g. Children playing in Open Age Cricket, Bowling Directives, Helmet safety, Extreme Heat guidance, Live Streaming guidance and Concussion

SAFER CULTURE

CSO visibility

CSO involved in welcome meeting for each Age Group squad and All Stars/Dynamos

Safer Communication
Use of Spond/Heja or similar app to communicate with members, rather than WhatsApp.

Coaching and Supervision ratios are communicated and adhered to by coaches/volunteers

Club is a welcome and safe space for all. An inclusive and diverse environment is clear though the committee, membership and playing opportunity that is available

How to report a concern is clear and communicated. Poster on noticeboard with a link/QR code to report a concern

Club take a zero tolerance to abuse and actively challenge and report poor behaviour
